Subj: EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER DIRECTIVE 20-009A: TRANSPORTATION FOR TENANT COMMAND ACTIVE DUTY PERSONNEL IN QUARANTINE OR ISOLATION FACILITIES

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To establish transportation guidelines for the Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPHH) tenant commands temporary lodging for Active Duty (AD) personnel traveling to Restricted of Movement (ROM) (Quarantine and/or Isolation) Facilities per reference (a).
- 2. <u>Transportation Process</u>. Guidelines and principles for transportation to ROM Facilities are as follows:
 - a. For all life threatening medical emergencies, contact 911.
- b. Tenant commands shall provide government transportation for service member(s) assigned to ROM Facilities.
 - c. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) requirements for transportation of personnel:
- (1) For ROM, all personnel in vehicle will wear cloth face coverings that meet the following criteria per references (b) and (c):
 - (a) Conservative appearance and not offensive
 - (b) Conform to the CDC guidance
 - (c) Fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
 - (d) Cover nose to chin
 - (e) Full face coverings (like ski masks) are not authorized
 - (f) Be secured with ties or ear loops
 - (g) Preferably include multiple layers of fabric if material is cloth
 - (h) Allow for breathing without restriction

Subj: EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER DIRECTIVE 20-009A: TENANT COMMANDS ACTIVE DUTY PERSONNEL ON RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT OR ISOLATION TRANSPORTATION

- (2) For individuals entering Isolation, the following (PPE) is required for transportation:
 - (a) Driver/Patient shall wear surgical masks and gloves.
 - (b) Air Conditioning should be set to maximum setting and rear windows open.
- (c) Ensure the individual entering ROM Isolation is safely seated the maximum distance from the driver.
- (d) Thoroughly wipe down all surfaces of the vehicle with bleach wipes or bleach solution.
