Subj: EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER DIRECTIVE 20-006A: RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT (ROM) PERSONNEL TRACKING

Ref: (a) CNO WASHINGTON DC NAVADMIN 113/20 Restriction of Movement (ROM)
Guidance Update

- 1. Cancellation of Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Directive 20-006.
- 2. In accordance with reference (a), Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPHH) Commanding Officer is required to track all Restriction of Movement (ROM) or Person Under Investigation (PUI) personnel residing in Navy Lodging (Unaccompanied Housing, NGIS, Navy Lodge, PPV family housing, BOTH Hunt and Hickam Communities) on and off installation. There is no need for installations to track tenant personnel in a ROM status in private residence/lodging.
- 3. JBPHH has over 250 tenant commands responsible for over 96,000 personnel across Oahu. JBPHH is able to accomplish this task by creating SharePoint tools on C4I for tenant commands to report key information, without violating Personal Identifiable Information or Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) requirements. In an effort to simplify and standardize tracking of all ROM Personnel on JBPHH, tenant commands are directed to provide daily updates regarding status of personnel via C4I.
- 4. Please follow these steps:

- b. Click +NEW REPORT
- c. Fill out all fields as required and click Save
- 5. Tenant commands will input the status (i.e. ROM, PUI, COVID-19+, or CLEAR) of their personnel for 14 days. When members are cleared of ROM status, change their status to CLEAR.
