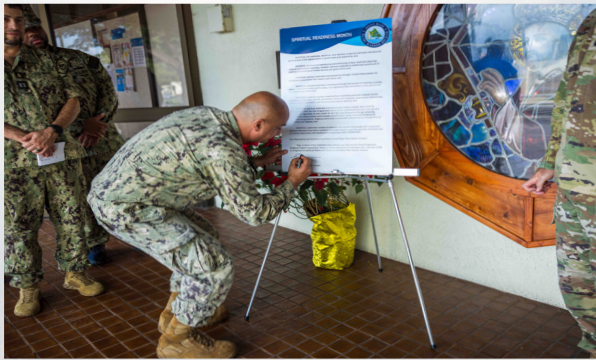

Pearl Harbor Survivor Ira "Ike" Schab Dies at 105

Ira "Ike" Schab, a World War II Navy veteran and one of the last remaining Pearl Harbor survivors passed away on Dec. 20 in Oregon. Schab had planned on attending the 84th annual Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day Ceremony but fell ill days before the Dec. 7 event. Schab enlisted in the Navy in 1939 and was serving as a Musician 1st Class aboard USS Dobbin (AD-3) during the Pearl Harbor attack. He spent the day passing ammunition to gunners.

On Jan. 9, 1942, Captain Homer Wallin took command of the Salvage Division of the Navy Yard following the attack on Pearl Harbor. The salvage operation was one of the largest of its kind, and through the efforts of the salvage crews, the damaged fleet was restored and placed back into service to contribute to victory in World War II.
