

**2023 ACO FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS
JULY 2024**

Q1. When will pressure washing of the tanks begin? How long will pressure washing last?

A1. Pressuring washing is scheduled to begin in mid-August with tanks 7 and 8 and will take approximately two months per tank.

Q2. What other steps are ahead of the closure of the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility?

A2. Closure of the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility includes the following steps:

- Site assessment
- Preparation of the tanks – degassing and sludge removal
- Installation of cleaning infrastructure
- Pressure washing
- Disposal of oily wash water
- Pipeline demolition
- Demobilization
- Decommissioning

Q3. Is there an updated timeline on when the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility will be closed?

A3. An updated timeline will be available to the public during the Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill open house on Aug. 21 from 5-7 p.m. at the Moanalua Terrace Community Center. The timeline will also be shared on our website www.navyclosuretaskforce.navy.mil

Q4. When is the expected closure date?

A4. Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill is still tracking to close the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility in 2028.
