

**2023 ACO
FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS & ANSWERS
DECEMBER 2023**

Q1. Where did the Red Hill fuel go and how much was allocated too each location?

Answer: Approximately 30 million gallons was transferred to the Campbell Industrial Park, Island Energy Services. Approximately 18 million gallons was transferred to above ground storage tanks on Joint Base Pearl Harbor Hickam to support operations and training requirements. The remainder of the fuel is being repositioned throughout the Indo-Pacific region based on operational needs.

Q2. Are the flares (tanks) at Campbell Industrial Park regulated and by who?

Answer: Operations at commercial facilities are regulated by local, state and federal regulations. Specific questions should be directed to Campbell Industrial Park.

Q3. Did the Navy or anyone notify the residents around Campbell Industrial Park that fuel was being moved?

Answer: No. The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) announces Federal contracting opportunities and award notifications to the public in accordance with the Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) and Defense Federal Acquisition Regulations (DFAR). Island Energy Services (IES) which operates the fuel terminal at Campbell Industrial Park is required to comply with all local, State, and Federal regulations to include any public notification requirements.

Q4: Is there a way for the public to access the Navy's Emergency Operations Complaint (EOC) Log which includes the dates and types of complaints that are received?

Answer: As required by the 2023 Administrative Consent Order (ACO), a summary of the Navy's EOC complaint log is accessible via the Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPHH) Safewaters website: <https://jbphh-safewaters.org>

Q5: Recently, the Navy released information regarding their air quality monitoring program and the installation of air monitoring stations across JBPHH, based on proximity to the Red Hill Facility. However, the Navy did not provide any information as to how or where the public could get access to air quality monitoring results:
